



- 1. Discornect the regitive cable from the battery


To rever eye injury from debris, were eye protection while drilling.

- 8. When you an satisfied that the marks are properly align d, remove the spoiler and center-runch each mark. Drill five 8 mm holes and on- 10 m hole through the marks as described.
 - Have in essistant hold the trunk lid oper while c illing t e holes.
 - First dr 1 pi ot noies with 3 mm and 5 mm chill bits; thin fine with the 8 or 10 mm drill bit.
 - Remove all bill re, and apply touch-up paint a each hole on the inside and outside of the trunk lit.







 With an assistant holding the trunk lid open, remove the center clip from the trunk springs.




 Remove the old trunk springs from the trunk hinge arms using the special tool provided. Wearing gloves, pull the tool toward you to rotate the spring.






19 Route tile soo er harness up through the left hole into the runk lid and out through the center hole. Connect the spoiler harness to the spoiler.



- 20 Secure he opt ler harness to the trunk hinger arm with one icing wire tie and three short wire ties.
- 21 Remove the trink light and unplug the 2-pir connect r.
- 22 Route t e spc er harness through the real shelf, ar i coni ect its 2-pin connectors to the connect r you list unplugged and to the trunklight.



- 23. Unplug the 2-pin connector from the high-mount brake light, and plug the connector to the 2-pin connector of the spoiler harness.
- 24. Loosen the bottom antenna mounting nut, and insert the bracket of the relay between the antenna bracket and the bottom nut. Retighten the nut securely.
- 25. Plug the 6-pin connector of the spoiler harness into the relay.
- 26. Unplug the 3-pin connector from the antenna motor. Connect the 2-pin connectors of the antenna harness to the connector just unplugged from the antenna motor.
- 27. Secure the antenna harness using one long wire tie.



- 28. Check that all wire harnesses and connectors are routed and connected properly.
- 29. Reconnect the negative cable to the battery.
- Check that the brake light comes on when the brake pedal is pressed.
- 31. Reinstall all removed parts.
- Enter the customer's radio anti-theft code, if applicable, and reset the radio station presets.
- 33. Reset the clock.
